## BEGINNING MODERN HEBREW

The aim of this course is to learn Hebrew as it is spoken in Israel today. There will be an emphasis on communication by creating a sense of community in which we can practice with partners, in groups, or as a whole class. We will work on the four main language skills: reading, writing, understanding and speaking. Note: You are invited to register for both Beginning classes, since they are scheduled one after the other, and each can reinforce the other!

DATES: 10 weekly sessions beginning Monday, Feb. 22  
BOOK: Ivrit Min Ha'hatchalah (Hebrew from Scratch)

## BEGINNING HEBREW FOR PRAYER AND TORAH

Hebrew is the ancient root of the Jewish people that animates our lives today. This course will provide students with basic Hebrew literacy through letter and vowel recognition and reading concepts. You will learn to read phonetically and acquire a basic vocabulary from the Friday night service. The goal is to enable students to confidently follow and participate in synagogue services. This class can be an introduction for the absolute beginner or for those who have taken Beginning Hebrew before and want a refresher course.

## INSTRUCTORS

HENIA LEWIN taught Hebrew at the University of Vermont, at Smith and Mount Holyoke colleges and at UMass Amherst. She has taught in Hebrew day schools and in synagogue schools for many years. In 1997, she was a recipient of the prestigious Covenant Award as an Outstanding Jewish Educator in North America. Henny attended elementary grades in Israel, Hebrew High School in Montreal, and graduated from the United Jewish Teachers Seminary in Montreal where she majored in Hebrew and Yiddish Studies. She earned a Masters in Education from the University of Vermont where she was a teaching fellow and later an instructor of Hebrew and Yiddish as well as director of Hillel on campus. During her sabbatical, Henny studied at Hebrew University in Jerusalem and taught Hebrew to new immigrants from the former Soviet Union.

AMELIA ENDER is the Jewish Chaplain at Mount Holyoke College in South Hadley. A long time member of Congregation B'nai Israel, she has taught in CBI's Adult Education program for the past seven years. In her own studies, she has almost completed a Masters in Jewish Studies at Hebrew College in Newton, MA.
